I further understand that a false affirmation in the execution of a "public document" is a serious matter, in that, Section 13A-10-1-2, Code of Alabama 1975, (as amended), provides that a false oath which misleads a public servant in the performance of his duty is a Class A misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year and/or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00. I also understand that the County Official who accepts this affidavit or agents of the State Revenue Department, State Examiners of Public Accounts, or any other law enforcement agency of this State may conduct a thorough investigation to determine the validity of this affidavit about the non-use of this vehicle on public streets, roads, and highways of this State.
